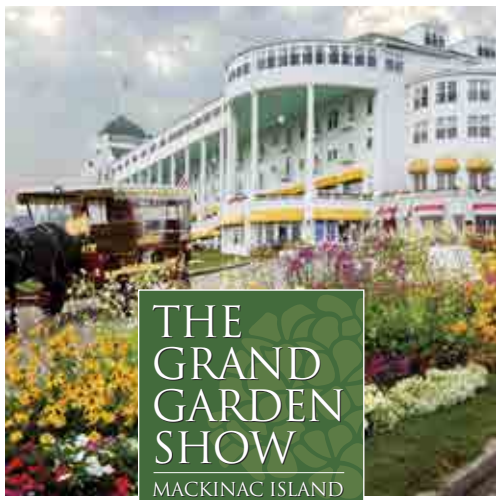

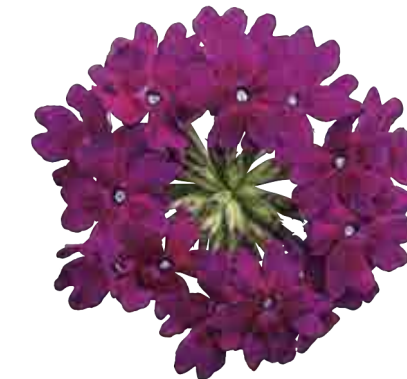
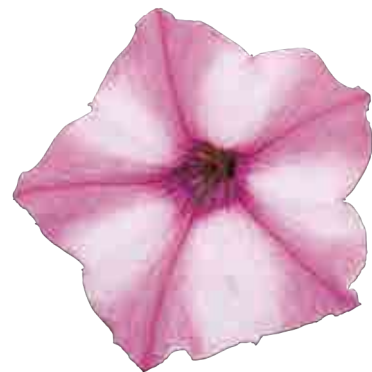

“Low Water Use” Defined:

Unlike many flowers which need daily watering, low water use plants require less water than typical. Their degree of tolerance of drier soils may vary due to humidity levels, soil type and other environmental factors in addition to the plants’ root and leaf structure.

Fabulous Perennial Foliage

Sometimes it's really not all about the pretty flowers. 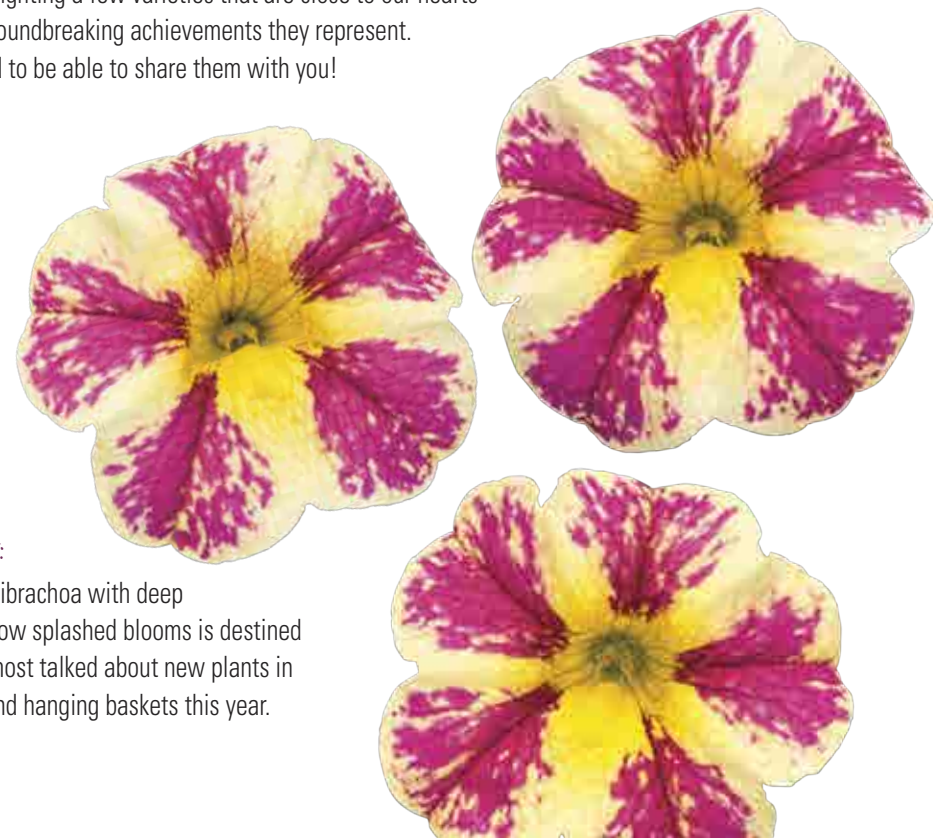
